## CRATER LAKE NATIONAL PARK

With a violent and spiritual past, Crater Lake National Park is one of Oregon's Seven Wonders. Crater Lake was formed from remnants of Mount Mazama's eruption 7,700 years ago and is now awed by sightseers, artists and photographers. The park offers hiking, biking, sightseeing, lodging, camping, and the Crater Lake Trolley, which takes your around the Rim Drive stopping at several sights of interest. [Learn More](#)


## KLAMATH WILDLIFE REFUGE

The Klamath Basin is renowned for its diversity of bird life due to its distinct habitats including marshes, open water, coniferous forest, Juniper woodlands, oak-chaparral, sagebrush-grasslands, grassy meadow and rocky cliffs.
